Description

Human B2GP1 produced in Human Plasma having a molecular mass of 50 kDa and pl of 5.6-6.4. It's a major phospholipid binding protein and an important component to measure in the assessment of anti-phospholipid syndrome. B2GP1 is also more specific than anti-cardiolipin antibodies and its presence correlates better with thrombotic risk.

Physical Appearance

Sterile Filtered White lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder.

Formulation

Lyophilized from 0.02M NH₄HCO₃.

Solubility

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized hB2GP1 in phosphate buffer, pH >7.0 containing 0.15M NaCI.

Purity

Greater than 96.0% as determined by:(a) Analysis by RP-HPLC.(b) Analysis by SDS-PAGE.

Stability

Human B2GP1 although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored between 2-8°C.
